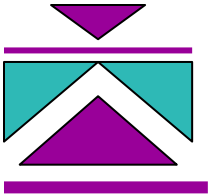

## CAP/C

*CAP/C is the Community Alternatives Program for Children. Services are provided for medically fragile children in the home environment rather than in an institution while maintaining the child's health, safety, and well-being.*

## CAP/C Program Provides

As a Medicaid waiver program CAPC allows some families to qualify that would not usually be eligible.

These families with children that are medically fragile receive a budgeted amount of Medicaid dollars to spend in the home on:

- Case Management
- In home aide or nurse assistance
- Supplies and Equipment
- Therapies
- Minor home modifications including widening doorways, wheelchair ramps and hand rails.

The services are geared to keeping children in the home, rather than in an institution.

## Benefits of CAP/C Case Management

- Help families navigate the maze of available resources
- Assist with school services
- Link between family and physician
- Identify resources within the community for families with special needs



## Making a CAP/C Referral

CAP/C referrals may be made by healthcare professionals, school staff, or family members. When a referral is made, the child's primary caregiver is contacted by a case manager. A series of questions is asked and the referral is submitted to the Division of Medical Assistance (DMA). DMA determines whether or not the child is eligible for an assessment. If eligible for an assessment, a case manager visits the child and the primary caregiver in the home environment, completes an assessment, and submits the information to DMA. DMA then determines if the child will be a participant in the program.
